Ref: Letter of Chief Commissioner dated 3.6.2011 in C.No. IV/11/12/2011

Please recall the discussion the Office Bearers of this Association had with your good self on 22.06.2011, during the course of which the incorrect responses of the Commissionerates in the Zone to the letter issued by DG(HRD) [ref:F.No.8/8/38/HRD(HRM)/2010 dated 2.6.2001] was brought to your notice.

Though the contents of the letter of DG(HRD) are not clear, it is our understanding that the reporting by the Commissionerates is inaccurate for the following reasons.


1. The letter calls for a specific response on the numbers of the documents (shipping bills and bills of entry) handled by the Central Excise Officers. The same had been viewed from the point of assessment and reported as NIL. The correct position is that for cenvat verification purposes, de-bonding, etc., in respect of EOUs and other units, a large number of documents (running into thousands) are handled by the Central Excise Officers.

2. Put illustratively, in the case of Service Tax Commissionerate, it has been reported against serial numbers 3 & 4 (shipping bills and bills of entry) that the documents handled by them as "N.A.". The fact is that in respect of refund of accumulated service tax credit of input/input services, etc., under Notification No.5/2006 approximately 80 claims are filed every month. In respect of each claim, thousand documents on an average are required to be scrutinized. In respect of Notification No.17/2009, which permits refund of input service tax credit, allowed on export of goods, same is the case.

The above are only indicative of the documents handled by the Central Excise Officers. A correct picture would emerge if there is an accurate reporting, which is requested to be done by the Commissionerates and the reports already sent by them have to be re-examined. This issue assumes importance in the light of the cadre restructuring presently underway and mentioned explicitly in the letter sent by DG(HRD). If not done, the career prospects of the Central Excise Officers would be impaired permanently.
