It has been brought to the notice of this Association that officers from Chennai city Commissionerates have been posted to Large Tax Payer Unit (LTU) without them having expressed their willingness. This Association humbly submits that the Large Tax Payer Unit (LTU) is a different entity and has been accorded a special status by the GOI and the Administrators is evidenced by the following:


1. The order of the CBEC P.No:AI2034/2/2009 Ad III B dated 17/03/2009 treating the tenure as a posting outside the Metro city of LTU concerned and extending the benefit to 3 years.
2. That it will be done on a selection basis of officers free from Vigilance angle and on merit.
3. That it will be done from amongst officers and staff of Tamilnadu & Puducherry Cadre.

The above three, make the posting to LTU on deputation basis, and it is desirable, that the willingness of the officer be obtained, before being posted to LTU. It is also that in view of 1 to 3 above, the posting to LTU, does not figure in the transfer policy, for the local zone. It is requested that, officers may be posted to LTU, on willingness expressed by them. Where there is no willingness, on the part of the officer concerned, the name may please be excluded and the order cancelled.

This Association also wishes to present a few more grievances to the Administration which will be done separately.
