Please refer the subject. It has been brought to the notice of this Association that Superintendents retained on promotion during the years 2008 and 2009 have been asked to exercise their option to places out side Chennai on the ground that such retentions ordered went against the policy of 2008.

In this backdrop, the Executive Committee of the association met and discussed the issue as also other issues related to Annual General Transfer 2011. It was decided in the EC that the directions to officers retained on promotion during the years 2008 and 2009, having been issued at the last minute is incorrect and the same was requested to be corrected by taking up the issue with the administration. It was also decided that cases deserving extreme compassionate consideration be also taken up for retention in Chennai City.

This association requests the Chief Commissioner to exclude the cases of Superintendents retained on promotion during 2008 and 2009 on the ground that they have not been put on adequate notice and any decision otherwise is likely to cause serious disturbance both on family and education grounds.

Please recall the discussions, the office Bearers of this Association had with your Goodself on 26th April 2011 during the course of which you were kind enough to hear us out to reduce the numbers going out of Chennai on AGT. In this context, the following steps are suggested:

The number of officers sent out on AGT during 2010 as well as on promotion who are to be brought back to Chennai on completion of two years period, total 23 (AGT 11 and officers sent out on promotion and have completed or about to complete two years - 12) only.

This can be achieved in two ways - (i) by sending out officers who are to be brought back from SEZ as well as from other organizations. This is because the significant number who were otherwise long standing in Chennai City had opted to go out to those organizations. (ii) by using the officers who were put on sufficient notice (from the 2010 review and AGT lists).

This Association will be extremely thankful to you if the above are implemented and the office bearers will be too glad to co operate in achieving the desired results.
