The Unit's views on the subject are furnished below.

1. Mass Resignation call is a bold one but should be backed up by great organizational mobilization. This will include meetings to be addressed by the Secretary General & President in at least 10 major and small cities. Such an effort will send a very strong message of seriousness of our agitation to the Authorities concerned. This will also help dispel the apprehensions of our members as also helping us in understanding the ground level strength.
- 2 The call will have a debilitating effect on CBEC if Inspectors are taken on board. This can be achieved by the immediate formation of a coordination committee of Associations of Superintendents & Inspectors both at the National level & Unit level on certain identified points of convergence which from our side can have pay matter from 1.1.1986[1.1.1996 as was made flexible in one of our AEC's at

Ludhiana during July 2011], Regularization of ad hoc promotions[From 01/01/97] in the grade of Assistant Commissioners in the current ratio of 13:2:1 and approval of CR without any cut in posts originally proposed in the grade of Assistant Commissioners.


3.On formation of such a coordination committee to call for a one day strike for ensuring better cohesion between the cadres at the field level before submission of mass resignations[which we will request our Inspector brethren also to participate].

Our unit strongly feels that the co option of Inspectors in the struggle for ensuring dignity to both the executive cadres are better achieved by such synergistic action.

Long term goal of having a common association of Superintendents & Inspectors [as is prevalent on Customs preventive side] will bear fruition when measures proposed against points 2 & 3 gain traction.
