## Committee on the issue of regional disparities

A few units in the Patna AEC meeting, keeping in view the thousands of promotions as per the result of the ongoing cadre restructuring, raised first time in the history of the Association the point of the removal of regional disparities in r/o the promotions to the post of AC on the basis of the seniority in Inspector cadre. The Pune Unit also placed some scheme in this regard saying that these regional disparities may be removed without adversely affecting the interest of anyone. A separate session was held to discuss the issue but the most of the units asked for the time to discuss the issue with their members. Accordingly, it was decided that the issue would be discussed in the next AEC meeting.

2. The issue was again discussed in the Associate Committee meeting of 21.09.13 in relation of the agenda point of the Scheme granting parity with common entry counterparts to enter our officers into PB4.

3. Therefore, as per the powers conferred upon the post of the Secretary General in terms of the proviso 10 (B) (vii) of the Constitution of the Association, a committee named the 'Committee on the issue of regional disparities' is hereby formed to study the measures how to remove the regional disparities in r/o promotion to the post of Asstt. Commissioner on the basis of the seniority in Inspector cadre without harming the interest of any member officer. As the Association is for all, the interest of every member & every unit is to be protected by the committee. Some officers/units may feel that some others are/would be at the advantageous/disadvantageous position on this issue particularly after being figured in the well-established seniority list. So, it is to be taken care of that no fragmentations occurs as per the result of the study of the committee. It is also to be studied whether the parity with the best placed common entry counterparts including CSS etc. would solve the problem by benefitting all without harming anybody. In addition to it, the committee will also study the measures to be taken for the grant of the parity with the best placed common entry counterparts including CSS etc. as they are already attaining the levels of Joint Secretary & Commissioner. All the related aspects are also to be studied specifically in details after duly consulting every unit without any exception after collecting the figures & data from all of our units & office bearers in view that interest of no unit/officer is harmed on the issue. The scheme of Pune Unit in this regard saying that these regional disparities may be removed without adversely affecting the interest of anyone may also be studied & consulted in detail with each unit/office bearer after procuring it from the said unit through Sh. P. D. Nimhan. The following officers will be the members of the committee-
