Sub : Transfer back to Chennai of Superintendents promoted & sent out of
Chennai during July 2011 – Regarding.

Ref : Order No.75/13 dt 29/8/13 issued from File C.No II/03/14/2013

I invite your kind attention to the subject and reference above stated. Kindly recall the discussions the office bearers had on the subject with your good self on quite a few occasions. During such discussions[with your good self as well as your predecessors] we were given to understand that the remaining few officers of 2011 batch of Superintendents [sent out of Chennai on promotion] will be brought back immediately when the first vacancies arise. To our disappointment this has not happened completely. When this issue was raised during October 2012 the then administration took the stand that requests in respect of the referred category of officers were not routed through proper channel and that it will be done at the earliest. It is almost an year since such an assurance was given and the remaining few officers of 2011 batch are yet to be brought back to Chennai City[though they have completed two years]. On the contrary deputation repatriates have been accommodated harming the former. It is requested that the 2011 batch of officers sent out on promotion may kindly be brought back to Chennai City immediately.

On the subject and during discussions, the association had also made a proposal, for releasing a good number of vacancies, from LTU to Central Excise Commissionerates in Chennai City [which on a stand alone basis have a shortage of staff when measured against sanctioned strength whereas the overall zone position shows surplus and this is in view of diversion of posts as well as persons from Chennai City Commissionerates] by diverting posts from Commissionerates in Coimbatore Zone, in terms of Administrative Instructions 02 & 03 issued by the Chief Commissioner during July 2008. It is requested that this exercise may please be undertaken immediately and the twin problems of vacancies in city commissionerates & accommodating those sent out on transfer can be addressed simultaneously.
