

Dear Comrades,

Please see the letter, dated 31-12-2013, of the Chairperson of sub-committee no.1 dealing with the conduct of DPCs in granting promotions in the ensuing cadre restructuring. As could be seen from the list appended to the aforesaid letter, nearly 285 names of the Superintendents [mostly of 1997 batch] of our zone, eligible for promotion as Assistant Commissioners are missing.

(Y)OUR Association of Chennai Unit was quick to realise this grave omission and took up matter with the Chief Commissioner and the Cadre Controlling Authority. Both of them were kind enough to take immediate remedial action by reporting the missing names of the officers and further sending the requisite documents to the committee. Still it is reported that the ACRs of about 75 officers are yet to be sent to the committee. The respective Vice-presidents/Joint Secretaries of each Commissionerate in this zone are urged to contact the Vigilance/CF sections to expedite forwarding of the documents specified in the sub-committee's letter. The Association is doing all the necessary follow-up work in this regard.
