Ref : Our Letters dt 24/09/14 & 22/14 dt 09/10/14 on the subject

Please recall the discussions the office bearers of this Association had with your good self and Commissioner cadre control on the 13th of this month. During the discussions one of the suggestions made by us on postings to formations in Chennai city was to post all those officers who have been promoted recently [on 30/09/14] as well as those who are to be brought back to Chennai to the new formations that have been created till a new policy is formulated. It was also suggested that for the present the guidelines dated 13/02/2008 be followed in respect of such postings. The following short points are made in pursuance of those already made.

1. Prior to 15/10/14 there was only one Service Tax Commissionerate in Chennai City and that the guidelines prescribed a tenure of Superintendents in Central Excise Commissionerates as six years and that of Service Tax Commissionerate as four. It is mentioned that there was no specific bar on transfer of officers who have completed six years in an Excise Commissionerate to another Central Excise Commissionerate.
2. The new zones of Central Excise & Service Tax have been created only now and it is felt that till such time a new policy is evolved and one which can be applied in the ensuing AGT [Local] in April 2015 the extant policy may please be followed.
3. It is felt that the complexities can be overcome by following the simple policy of posting all those who have been promoted recently to the new formations that have been created post CR at Chennai. It is also mentioned that there can be no question of attributing inexperience to such officers as almost all of them have served in the executive cadre for 16-18 years and have been found fit to occupy the supervisory post.

It is, therefore, requested that till such time a new policy is formulated officers in formations other than those that have come into existence recently the existing policy may please be allowed to continue.
