I would like to bring to your kind notice the losses/damages suffered by the staff working in Chennai/Cuddalore/Puducherry[All under Chennai CCA]. The losses /damages are varied and are broadly classified as may be seen from the heads given below.

1. Loss/Damage to office premises and equipments including Electrical Equipments
2. Loss/Damage to Department Vehicles
3. Loss/Damage to Houses and personal vehicles of officers
4. Loss/Damage to Personal Vehicles of Officers parked in Office Premises
5. Other collateral damages that would have occurred but would surface during Evaluation

It is requested that appropriate relief may please be provided as and when the actual damages are ascertained and quantified as also submitted through appropriate authorities.

Further, I have been directed to inform that since the reasons for absence is beyond the control of Officers and due to natural calamity, the requests received from Officers, if any, for sanction of Special Casual Leave may be considered by the respective HoD.



You may be aware of the large scale devastation & destruction caused by heavy rains in Chennai during the first week of December resulting in a massive flooding of the city.
