respectively[numbered as 26 & 27 incorrectly earlier and being amended now]

Through the above cited references we had sought an appointment to discuss various issues which warrant intervention at your level which is yet to come through. Among other issues to be discussed remain the serious issue of huge vacancies and improper deployment. The present vacancy position in Chennai Central Excise Zone & Service Tax Zone[barring Puducherry, LTU & LTU[Audit] Chennai is 114 & 144]. In complete derogation to the fact of such huge vacancies another order 02/15 dt 12/01/15 has been issued transferring 5 officers to LTU[Audit]. No serious effort from the administration side seems to have been taken to address the grievances.

It is requested that

- [i] to stop posting officers from Chennai City to LTU & LTU[Audit] as they have a pan Indian identity and are at least required to filled up by officers from all formations within the common seniority zone of Tamil Nadu & which issue has been taken up consistently by this association for the last eight years and to keep the order 02/15 in abeyance till resolution of this issue.
- [ii] to immediately convene a grievance redress meeting in terms of instructions issued by CBEC to discuss problems raised through letter 31/14 dt 19/12/14 and those raised above.
