CIRCULAR NO.06/AIACEGEO/2009

Now festival season is over and it is hoped that our members have enjoyed the festivals. The VI CPC failed to give justice to our members so far as granting of scale corresponding to Rs.8000-13500/ and retrospective effect of the scale of Rs.7500-12,000/ from 01.01.1996. The association succeeded to get some benefit from the recommendation of the Fast Track Committee headed by Hon'ble Revenue Secretary. The non functional scale corresponding to Rs.8000-13,500 on completion of four years has been given and benefit of three ACP on completion of thirty years of service. The disparity in granting of NFS scale is known to all and the association has taken up the said anomaly with the Departmental Anomaly Committee. After vigorous persuasion, the favourable clarification of counting of four years has come but this time with the clause of vigilance clearance which was not there in the clarification issued in the month of November, 2008. The association has taken up this point with the Board. Also coming to know that in some places while fixing the pay on 01.01.2006 in the NFS, the increment has not been given and so the said matter has been taken up with Board. The members who have completed four years as Superintendent on 01.01.2006 would be entitled to get one increment on 01.01.2006 and thereafter normal increment on 01.07.2006. regarding grant of benefit of third ACP under MACP Scheme, thanks to cadre controlling authority of North East Commissionerates who have given the grade pay of Rs.6600/ on completion of thirty years who were drawing the scale of AC(JTS) due to 2nd financial up gradation. As usual, the CBE&C is slow to guide the field formation particularly the adamant and unwilling PAOs to grant the legitimate benefit to a cadre who is reeling under severe stagnation and pay erosion.

The association succeeded to convince the Joint Secretary(Admn.) and Member(P&V) that the only solution to remove stagnation and give proper administrative support to implement the liberalized taxation laws lies with making of separate Service Rules for the Central Excise Group 'B' Executive Officers(Gazetted and non-Gazetted). Accordingly they recommended for such Rules in January, 2009 but there after intriguing feature noticed to some how bury the said suggestion. Even the association has not been consulted thereafter about reports submitted by High Powered Committee and Study Groups. In view of the indifferent attitude of the Board, the association decided to go for dharna and march to parliament in the month of September, 2009 and postponement of the said programme in the circumstances of meeting with Hon'ble Finance Minister on 25.08.09 in his residence and no parliament session in the said month, has been circulated in the earlier circular. Now the association has sent notice to the Board to stage dharna at Jantar Mantar followed by peaceful procession to Parliament to hand over memorandum to Hon'ble PM and FM on 30th November, 2009. It was also decided to stage dharna on the same day in the offices of Chief Commissioner/ Commissioner throughout the country. The copy of the notice is sent herewith to serve the same to the Chief Commissioner/ Commissioner. A letter is also sent herewith to use the same to invite MPs at Jantar Mantar. Also a press note is enclosed to hand over the same for circulation in the News Papers and telecast in the electronic media. The unit Secretaries and all India Office Bearers are requested to convene meetings to give wide publicity of the programme and also ensure participation in Delhi and offices of Chief Commissioner/ Commissioner. The units situated nearer to Delhi must try to bring maximum participants.
