Madam,

Please recall the discussions the office bearers of this unit had with you in the AN of 03/01/11. As desired, I am submitting the note on grievances as well as the decisions taken in the meetings held on 03/01/11 & 04/01/11.

1. Denial of 6600 Grade Pay and improper fixation of pay in respect of Superintendents in Chennai Zone - Inaction on the part of Dept. in addressing the problems posed by the PAO Estt in Chennai

Enclosed please find proof of payment of 6600 Grade Pay [Pay Slips, LPC (as applicable)] from Kochi, Delhi, Meerut, Bhubaneswar, Kolkata, Shillong, Hyderabad, Pune, Lucknow - C.Ex formations & Chennai Custom House.

Please also find enclosed pay slips/order evidencing payment of 5400 GP in PB 3 to Superintendents in Kolkata, Patna, Bhubaneswar, Lucknow, Delhi to those who have been given ACP between 01.01.06 and 31.08.08 under the old scheme as well as to those who have been given 2nd MACP under the new scheme. Request that necessary instructions be issued to all the AO's [DDO] in the Zone to address the problem of fixation properly instead of resorting to seeking clarifications when it is not necessary in the light of clear instructions issued by the Govt.

It has also been observed that AO's are completely disinclined to address the grievances pertaining to fixation of pay as also other issues post implementation of VI CPC decisions and cite the obstructionist tactics of the PAO for such inaction. Members are completely demoralized and a number of Superintendents have retired w/o deriving the pay benefits conferred on them by the VI CPC. In the process it is the Govt's decisions on pay matters that are not honoured.

2. Non observance of policy provisions contained in C. No II/3/51/2008 dated 13/2/08 issued by the Cadre Control Authority in order 91/10|File C. No II/3/29/2010 CCA Estt -

Please refer our letters 39/10 dt 20/9/10, 41/10 dt 06/10/10, 43/10 dt 12/10/10, 44/10 dt 13/10/10 as also letter dt 29/11/10 on the subject.

The order 91/10 is in complete violation of the policy dt 13/2/08 and has retained 17 out of 29 officers promoted from Chennai City when the policy says on promotion officers are liable to be posted outside except those suffering from serious illness. However the retentions have been ordered based on AGT norms as well as on flexible terms which have already been pointed out illustratively in our earlier letters. The case of Mr. N. Raman who is due to retire in about 25 months time for retention have been taken up repeatedly. Eight officers who were transferred out earlier on promotion in terms of the policy of 2008 and liable to be brought back were ignored.

The decisions taken are communicated below.


1. To seek interest on the delayed payment of correct grade pay in respect of all categories mentioned above.
2. To request the Administration to bring back the eight officers to Chennai City without replacements immediately as also retain Mr. N. Raman who is due to retire in two years time in Chennai city.
