Sub : Posting on promotion in the grade of
Superintendents of Central Excise in complete
disregard of policy -Regarding

Ref : Letter 43/10 dated 12/10/10 addressed to Chief
Commissioner, Central Excise, Chennai Zone a
copy of which has been marked to your office.

I wish to bring to your notice the contents of Order 91/10 dated 12 /10/10 on the subject and to state that in so far as it relates to posting on promotions to the grade of Superintendents of Central Excise from Chennai Zone are concerned the policy issued by the Cadre Control Authority vide C. No II/3/51/2008 dated 13/2/2008 [Copy Enclosed] have not been followed and 11 officers have been retained on promotion in violation of Para 4 of the policy aforementioned. That these retentions [11 in number] act against the spirit of the policy could be glaringly seen when contrasted with Para 6 of the same policy which enables the transfer back of officers who have gone out on promotion in the earlier years and have not been brought back despite having completed the stipulated tenure in terms of the policy. That the policy has been implemented by the Administration during the earlier years and even in the recent promotion to the

grade of Inspectors of Central Excise makes the present order disturb the consistency that is required in such matters need no elaboration. The retentions have been ordered at a time when there are around eight[8] requests pending [in complete violation of policy] and this Association feel compelled to seek your intervention as despite three letters[Lrs 39/10 dt 20/9/10,41/10 dt 06/10/10(before issue) and 43/10 dt 12/10/10(After issue)] addressed to the Chief Commissioner [Copy Enclosed] there has not been any response so far and the problem remains unresolved till now.
This Association requests your intervention in the matter urgently as the deadline for the order is 29/10/10.
