Please refer Commissioner's letter C. No I/2/01/2010 –
Admn dated 30.09.2010 on the subject. The following
points are sponsored for discussion and Resolution.

1. Bills pending with AO[DDO]

Medical reimbursement bills are held up for a long
time[in some cases more than one year] as also LTC
claims that are taken up for sanction after a substantial
lapse of time. As on date many claims are pending proper
sanction for more than a year.

2. Non Payment of Arrears

NFSG arrears[5400 Grade Pay given to
Superintendents on completion of four
Years] have not been properly disbursed in some
cases and in respect of some
others have not been disbursed at all.

3. Cleanliness of premises

It has been stated that the cleanliness in the
premises require to be improved and the state of closets
are not hygienic.

4. EPABX

The numbers of lines are insufficient [both in MHU and Ananda] and may be increased.

5. Legal digests and periodicals

STR and other periodicals/legal digests may please be supplied to all formations/sections as access is being denied to officers in view of ~~non~~ supply.

6. Posting/Transfer orders are not being marked to Associations for a pretty long time And to begin with orders from April 10 till date may be given.

7. Fixation of pay consequent on VI CPC decisions has not been done properly in some cases and it may please be ensured that all second ACP cases under ACP Scheme of 1999 are given fixation in accordance with the orders issued by GoI [Cases till 31/08/08 are to be fixed in PB 3 with grade pay 5400 and award of 6600 GP to be given on completion of 30 years]

8. MACP orders to be implemented immediately as entitlements like LTC, Travel Allowance etc are fixed in line with the Grade Pay and many officers have retired without drawing their entitlements under MACP Scheme.

9. Any other oral point/supplementary question may be allowed based on the outcome of the discussion.
